Choose Your Teacher

(Psalm 1:1-2, CEV) God blesses those people who refuse evil advice and won't follow sinners or join in sneering at God. Instead, the Law of the Lord makes them happy, and they think about it day and night.

Attend Worship

(Exodus 20:8) Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

Spend time daily with God

(Matthew 4:4, Msg) It takes more than bread to stay alive. It takes a steady stream of words from God's mouth.

Read His Book

(Psalm 119:11) I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Practice Listening for His Voice

(John 10:27) My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

Commit yourself to a small group inside the church

(Mark 9:2) After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them.

(Mark 14:32-33) They went to a place called Gethsemane, and Jesus said to his disciples, "Sit here while I pray." He took Peter, James and John along with him, and he began to be deeply distressed and troubled.

Do the Word

(James 1:23-25) Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it-- he will be blessed in what he does.
