

# With Heads Held High

Leviticus 26:13

*I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians; I broke the bars of your yoke and enabled you to walk with heads held high.*

**GOD HAS BROUGHT US OUT OF SLAVERY**

**A. The Hebrew people looked to the exodus from Egypt as the time when God set them free.**

**B. Christians look to the cross and empty tomb of Jesus as the time when God set us free.**

**GOD'S FREE PEOPLE CONTINUE TO LIVE  
LIKE SIN'S SLAVES**

*(Leviticus 26:13)...brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves...*

**HOW DO WE LIVE AS GOD INTENDS,  
WITH OUR HEADS HELD HIGH?**

**A. Build your life upon what God has done for you.**

*I broke the bars of your yoke...*

**B. Know that God is greater than your heart.**

*(1 John 3:19-20) This then is how we know that we belong to the truth, and how we set our hearts at rest in his presence whenever our hearts condemn us. For God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything.*

**C. Feast in the presence of your enemies.**

*(Psalm 23:5a) You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies.*

**D. Put away childish things.**

*(1 Corinthians 13:11) When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put childish ways behind me.*

*(John 8:32) Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.*

**E. Hear your Heavenly Father's song of love.**

*(Zephaniah 3:17) The LORD... will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with singing.*

**Walk with your head held high.**
