

Who's in Charge?

1 Peter 3:15a

(1 Peter 3:15a) But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord.

Who is the Lord of your life?

(Matthew 7:21) "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

Something or someone is in charge of your life right now.

We can make ourselves the Lord of our lives.

Your group can become your Lord.

An addiction can become the controlling power over your life.

We can give church leaders the place that belongs to Jesus alone.

(1 Corinthians 1:12-13) What I mean is this: One of you says, "I follow Paul"; another, "I follow Apollos"; another, "I follow Cephas"; still another, "I follow Christ." Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Were you baptized into the name of Paul?

(Colossians 1:18) And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.

Questions that will lead you to the one in charge in your life:

Who sets my schedule?

(Psalm 31:15, Msg) Hour by hour, I place my days in Your hand.

Who tells me how to spend my money?

Who decides what is right and what is wrong?

Who tells you who to love and who not to love?

(John 6:60) "This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?"
