JESUS SAYS, "I LOVE YOU"

A> When love touches your life, it changes your life.

B> When the love of Jesus touches your life, it changes everything.

C> God loves you so much that he gave all that was needed to give you a new life.

(John 3:16) "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

D> We resist love because we know we are sinners.

JESUS SAYS, "I FORGIVE YOU"

(Romans 6:23) "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

A> You'll die trying to overcome your sin on your own.

B> Real life, before and after you die, is a free gift that we receive or reject.

C> We hesitate to receive God's gift because we fear what He might ask in return.

JESUS SAYS, "I WILL GUIDE YOU TO AN ABUNDANT LIFE"

(John 10:10) "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."

A> No price is too high to pay for life.

B> When you know that your soul is at stake, no price could be too high to follow Jesus.

C> Jesus asks us to receive his gift and put it to work in the world.

D> In putting your gift to work in the world, you find abundant life.

JESUS SAYS, "I STAND AT THE DOOR OF YOUR HEART AND KNOCK"

(Revelation. 3:20) "Here I am! I stand at the door and knock."

A> Hearing a knock on your door leads you to make a choice.

B> When you know that Jesus wants to enter your life, you must make a choice.
