Make a You Turn with God

Acts 26:19, NRSV

"After that, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision, but declared first to those in Damascus, then in Jerusalem and throughout the countryside of Judea, and also to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God and do deeds consistent with repentance.

The road to salvation and eternal life is a one-way street.

(John 14:6) Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Apart from Christ, if you know it or not, you are going in the wrong direction.

(Proverbs 14:12) There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death.

(Matthew 7:13-14) "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

God is crying out to you to warn you of the danger of going the wrong way.

(John 16:8) When the Helper comes, he will prove this to the people of the world that they are wrong. They are wrong about what they call bad and about what they call good. He will show them how to be right with God. He will show them about God's judgment.

You repent (make a "You Turn" with God) when you:

Let God's loving warning change your mind.

(Acts 26:19) I declared...that they should repent...

Change the one you're facing.

(Acts 26:19) ...and turn to God...

Looking to God, change the way you're living.

(Acts 26:19) ...and do deeds consistent with repentance.

"Is your Christian walk taking you anywhere?"

(Hebrews 4:7b) "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts."

If your life is going in the wrong direction, you can make a "you turn" today.
