

# Make a You Turn with Your Child

## From Periphery to Priority

*(Malachi 4:6) He will teach parents how to love their children. He will also teach children how to honor their parents. If that does not happen, I will come. And I will put a curse on the land."*

## From Pleasing to Loving

As a parent, you cannot always please your children and love them at the same time.

*(Proverbs 13:24) A refusal to correct is a refusal to love; love your children by disciplining them.*

*(Hebrews 12:11) No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.*

## From Put-Down to Uplifted

*(Ephesians 6:4, msg) Fathers, don't exasperate your children by coming down hard on them. Take them by the hand and lead them in the way of the Master.*

The biggest issue is not that you are big, but that God is great.

## From Obstacle to Example

*(Titus 2:7) In everything set them an example by doing what is good.*

*(1 Corinthians 11:1) Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.*

If you're not following Jesus, you're blocking your child's way to Christ.

## From Delay to Decision

*(Deuteronomy 30:19b) Now choose life, so that you and your children may live.*
