How To Pack A Shoe Box

1. Pick up a box in the church office or use your own empty shoe box or small plastic container. You can wrap the box (lid separately), but wrapping is not required.
2. Determine whether your gift will be for a boy or a girl and the child's age category: 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14. Mark the correct age category on the label, and tape the label to the top of your box.
3. Fill the box with a variety of small gifts such as: small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoo's, yo-yos, jump ropes, small Etch-A-Sketch, toys that light up or make noise, Slinky, etc. You may also include school supplies, hygiene items, t-shirts, socks, hair clips, toy jewelry, flashlights.
4. Include your donation of \$7 or more for each shoe box you prepare to help cover shipping and other project costs. You can give online, or you can use the donation envelope. Make checks payable to Samaritan's Purse and place it in an envelope on top of the gift items inside your box. If you are preparing more than one box, please make one combined donation.
5. Place a rubber band around each closed shoe box and drop off at the church office by **November 13**.
6. Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift.
