Help our Child Development Center This Sunday

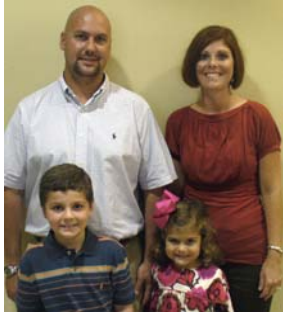
