#### Items needed in June: Peanut Butter

Our Reaching Center continues to help those in need in our community every Tuesday morning. Please help us keep the shelves stocked by purchasing a few extra items as you grocery shop each week.



As you know, we had to postpone DNOW and cancel our overnight summer trips due to the COVID-19 crisis. However, as our state continues to open back up, we are cautiously planning at this time to have a modified version of DNOW this summer with proper social distancing measures in place. In order to accommodate these social distancing measures, the event will not be a weekend/overnight event this year; instead, it is going to take place for two hours on three individual Wednesday evenings: June 24, July 1, and July 8 from 6:30-8:30. Each Wednesday session will build on the week before and will consist of a socially distanced worship gathering, a socially distanced small group discussion, and an individually boxed dinner. Here's the good news: because of this adjusted format, DNOW will not cost as much this year, which means that everyone who registered last spring will be receiving a partial refund. If your student was not registered for DNOW in March but would like to attend these summer gatherings, we would love for him/her to do so! As long as supplies last, your student will have access to the same merchandise as the rest of the group.

While we've had to make some adjustments and modifications to make this event happen, we believe God has something very special planned for us over these weeks—and our prayer is that in the midst of all the chaos around us, God will speak into each of our students' hearts, drawing students into a relationship with Himself and spurring them on to the next step in their walk with Jesus. We believe God has something glorious in store for us this summer, and we want your student to be a part of it.
