# World War II Book Author and friend to Paul Stegall to Speak at BFBC

Robert Baumer has been writing about World War II for nearly 30 years. Bob's latest book is entitled *The Journey of the Purple Heart*, wherein he tells the moving story of his late uncle's WWII experiences in the famous First Infantry Division, and the friendship he formed during the war with the late Paul Stegall.

Mr. Stegall was a WWII veteran serving in the 1st Infantry Division throughout North Africa, Sicily and Europe having participated in the D-Day landing on Omaha Beach, June 6, 1944.

Mr. Stegall was an active member of BFBC for nearly 50 years. He served several terms as a Deacon, was a Sunday School member and a fixture as an usher. Even after he could no longer drive, he would be ushering at The Living Christmas Tree.
