We still strongly encourage masks and social distancing. Second, if you are in a high-risk group, we encourage you to be a part of *Back to Church Sunday* by joining us online. Our online technology has significantly improved since the COVID-19 outbreak, and we are in the process of updating all of our video and streaming capabilities. It's always best to join together in person, but this is one of those times when we are thankful that modern technology helps us remain connected.
