Exciting Kid's Ministry News!

On October 21st, we will begin a brand new Kid's ministry called KidzLife. KidzLife is a children's ministry for children in Kindergarten through 5th grade. The Mission Statement of KidzLife is: To help kids and leaders learn what the kingdom of God is all about by knowing Jesus and His Word. The Vision of KidzLife includes: That the world would be transformed when generations of kids and leaders live out the Kingdom of God in their homes, schools, jobs, and neighborhoods to the praise of His glory.
