Are you wanting to grow in your relationship with God? Are you wanting to become a better disciple who is a disciple maker? Discipleship Groups will help you take the next steps in your faith. This is an important process for every believer that provides intimate friendships, an environment of accountability, and, most importantly, cultivates a life rooted deeply in God's Word.

A Discipleship Group (D-Group) is a genderspecific, closed group of 3-5 believers who meet together weekly or bi-weekly for the purpose of growing in God's Word together. D-Groups provide believers the opportunity to intentionally develop their spiritual walk with Christ through Scripture reading and memorization, journaling, prayer, and relational accountability with the purpose of replicating faithful followers of Christ. The time commitment will be 1-1.5 hours per week or bi-weekly for 12 months, with the content being Bible-based, Christ-focused, and Gospel-centered. D-Groups are meant to be done off campus at your work, coffee house, home, or even at a local restaurant.

Expectations for D-Groups: participants should adhere to D-Group covenants and prayerfully consider taking an active role in future group replication. The end goal would be for participants to replicate themselves and start new D-Groups in fulfillment of the Great Commission.

If you would like to lead a D-Group or just be a part of a D-Group, please see Ryan Pate. We will have a D-Group Launch Event on January 4, 2024, at 6:30 pm in the Senior Adult Building. The D-Group Launch Event will help train leaders and members for the D-Groups. We will begin our D-Groups on January 8, 2024.
