Vote to Call Pastor Nahun Gil as Hispanic Minister of BFBC

Over the last two years, we have been blessed to partner with LaRoca Baptist Church in Hispanic ministry and outreach. God has used this time to help us better see the beauty of multiethnic ministry. Our mission as a church is to make disciples by helping people connect with Christ. Jesus defined the scope of our mission when He said, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).

While we are still under His mandate to go and make disciples of all nations, God has brought many nations to us. It is not uncommon to have 6 to 8 different nationalities represented on our campus each week. When we have combined with LaRoca for worship, the scene reminds us of John's vision in Revelation 7:9, "After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, saying, 'Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne and to the Lamb.'" What a great blessing and joy it is to see this representation of the coming Kingdom among us!

As we progressed through the last two years, our vision for Hispanic ministry has become clearer. During this time, Pastor Nahun Gill has been serving as the interim Pastor of LaRoca. Through much prayer, the Lord has led Nahun to step down as interim Pastor. The vision to which the Lord has led us is calling Nahun to serve as part of our ministry staff. This model of ministry will allow us to be one church. Through conversations with denominational leaders and other pastors, this model is proving to be the most successful model for advancing Kingdom work among the Hispanic population.

With the recommendation of the Personnel Committee, we will be voting to call Nahun Gil as our Hispanic Minister on March 17th during our 10:15 service. During the service, you will have the opportunity to hear Nahun share his testimony and vision for making disciples among our Hispanic population. As we have gotten to know Pastor Nahun and his family, their devotion to ministry and reaching the lost has been most evident. With an affirmative vote of our church family, Nahun will begin leading our Hispanic services and ministries immediately.

As this new model of ministry begins, our partnership with LaRoca has concluded. LaRoca Baptist Church will continue as its own autonomous church in a new location. It has been a privilege and joy to partner with them!

The Lord has been faithfully guiding us toward this exciting new addition to the ministry of Berea FBC. We look forward to how the Lord is going to grow His church through this ministry model! The Lord has placed our church here for just such a time as this. Please be in prayer for our special day on March 17th. -- Pastor Chad
