Prayer Ministry Celebration Day

More than 20 years ago, a group of prayer warriors began to pray for God to transform Berea First Baptist Church into a House of Prayer. After visiting churches with established prayer ministries and continuing to seek God's heart, two rooms were dedicated close to the current Chapel for use as prayer rooms.

Now, 20 years later, the prayers of this faithful group have been answered in ways that were exceedingly abundantly more than they could have asked or imagined. BFBC is still in the process of becoming the house of prayer that we believe God intends, but today, we have not on'ly the ministry of intercessory prayer, but ministries that focus on praying for our staff ministry team, our students, homebound and widowed members. Also, a men's prayer group meets weekly, a grandmothers in prayer group meets monthly, and our prayer-walking ministry provides multiple opportunities during the year for praying "on-site with in-sight".

In addition, we offer specific times of corporate prayer throughout the year, periodic classes focusing on a specific aspect of prayer life, and an annual prayer conference. Located in the Welcome Center is a Prayer Ministry Center with a variety of resources to help individuals grow in prayer.

On Sunday, March 24th, a portion of our morning worship service will be devoted to celebrating what God is doing as we pray, along with the opportunity for each member of the BFBC family to commit to a one-year involvement in one or more of our churchwide prayer ministries. As I reflect on those who responded to the promptings of the Holy Spirit 20 years ago, I can only imagine what the next 20 years will bring as we continue our journey toward becoming the House of Prayer God has in mind!
