

Stewardship

The word 'stewardship' seems somewhat uncommon today. Yet, the Bible has much to tell us about its meaning. In the Bible, the word stewardship refers to someone who 'manages' someone else's belongings or resources. In the Bible, we realize that as the Creator of the heavens and the earth, God is the owner of the universe. Everything belongs to Him!

The doctrine of biblical stewards affirms God's ownership and man's accountability to God as steward or manager of His resources. We see this accountability to God in Jesus' Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30). You'll remember in this parable that the Master entrusted three of his servants with a certain amount of money or resources before leaving on a journey. After a lengthy trip, he returned, and the stewards gave an account of what they had done with his resources. Two of the three invested his resources and gave back to him double the amount originally given. The third steward had not invested his Master's money and gave back the same amount he had received. The Master celebrated the faithfulness of the first two stewards and rewarded them. The third steward lost what had been entrusted to him and was cast out.

As we consider the biblical doctrine of stewardship, let's consider who is managing the resources God has entrusted to us. Are we using everything He's entrusted to us on ourselves? To what extent are we investing His resources in Kingdom work? If our Master were to return today, would He be pleased with how we currently steward the resources He's entrusted to us? Considering stewardship means we can adjust how we manage what the Lord has entrusted to us.
